At its 14th session dated 2 September, and in regard to Point 6 of the Agenda, the Rector's Council adopted the following

CONCLUSIONS

1. We consider the idea to found the MedILS as undoubtedly positive. The idea itself to found the Institute is a credit to one of our reputable academics, Miroslav Radman, the Croatian and Split academic community and all of Croatia. The Croatian academic community expects that the Institute, led by Academic Miroslav Radman, will represent a powerful impetus towards developing science and tertiary education in Croatia, particularly as it will attract the most successful scientists from the entire world to Split and will educate young scientists.
2. The Rector's Council supports the Croatian Government in its endeavour, and in keeping with available means, to assist in creation of the appropriate spatial conditions for the Institute to conduct its activities.
3. Croatian universities, and the University in Split in particular, have from the very start made themselves available and wish to be included in the development and management of the Institute as far as it is necessary. The activities so far by the Minister of Science, Education and Sports Dragan Primorac, Dr. Sc. and the University of Split and its Rector Ivan Pavić, Dr. Sc. to find appropriate solutions regarding the management of the Institute and a minimum level of participation by the University of Split in management bodies of the Institute is considered positive by the Rector's Council. The scientific activities of the Institute continue to be entirely independent and open to scientific and ethical evaluation.
4. In its endeavours to make the MedILS project as successful as possible the Rector's Council shall directly engage qualified scientific institutes and scientists to respond to any invitation to discuss and assist in creating a programme of activities for the Institute.
5. The University of Split will regularly report to the Rector's Council any developments concerning the founding of the Institute.
